




Pen Tool Tutorial








step 2




After making sure you have your stroke in front, you want to select the pen tool, selected with black, in yout tool bar. You can now place your first anchor. the above picture shows the before and after of

step 3



You can now move a little further down your line. On lines with a curve you want to place as many anchors as you can so it looks more natural and it is easier for you to maniplulate.

step 4



On Straighter tracing paths you can simply place the anchors at the corners.

step 5

placing anchor.



With full ojects you will need to connect the first and last anchor points you made to make a full shape.

step 6



If an anchor you made is not in the right place or you simply want to move it in some way you can select individual anchors with your White Direct Seletion Tool. On curves it also allows you to change the angle of the curve.

These are the tools on the tool bar you will be using for this assignment.

Remember:

You need your "stroke" selected for this project

and not your "fill".
