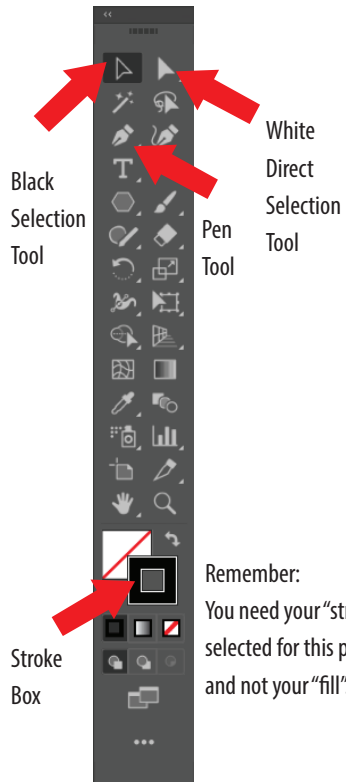


step 1



Black Selection Tool

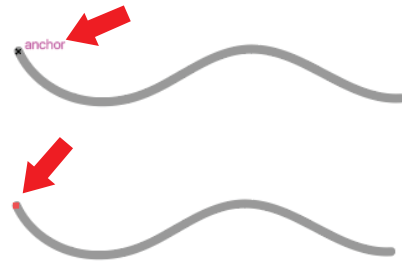
White Direct Selection Tool

Remember: You need your "stroke" selected for this project and not your "fill".

Stroke Box

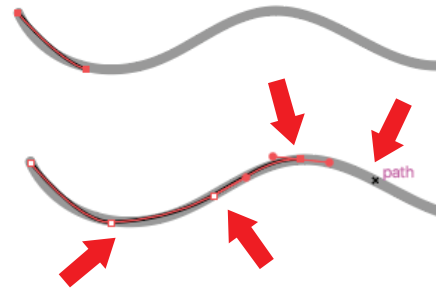
These are the tools on the tool bar you will be using for this assignment.

step 2



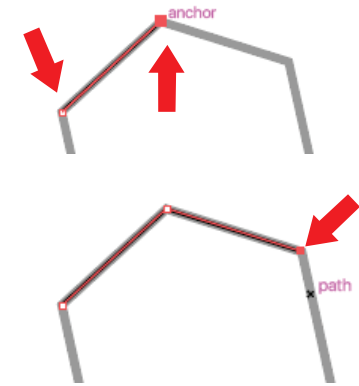
After making sure you have your stroke in front, you want to select the pen tool, selected with black, in your tool bar. You can now place your first anchor. the above picture shows the before and after of placing anchor.

step 3



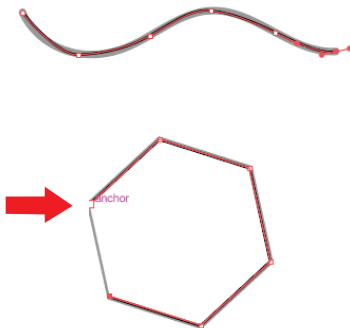
You can now move a little further down your line. On lines with a curve you want to place as many anchors as you can so it looks more natural and it is easier for you to manipulate.

step 4



On Straighter tracing paths you can simply place the anchors at the corners.

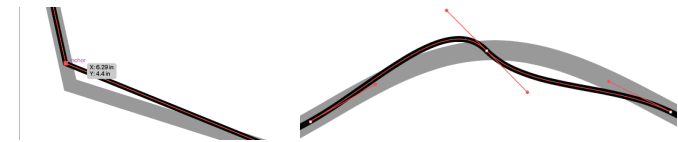
step 5



On curves and lines once you are done you can simply deselect the object by clicking off the object with your Black Selection Tool.

With full objects you will need to connect the first and last anchor points you made to make a full shape.

step 6



If an anchor you made is not in the right place or you simply want to move it in some way you can select individual anchors with your White Direct Selection Tool. On curves it also allows you to change the angle of the curve.
