Reaction Paper Essay 1: Design

- 1. Please discuss in your own words why the author of *On Creativity* thinks being creative is not the same as being expressive. How can you link this to Leslie Marmon Silko's emphasis on creative storytelling?
- 2. Why does the author believe that being merely creatively gifted is not a qualification for design expertise?
- 3. Why does the author say that creativity is as dangerous as a firearm?
- 4. Why are constraints a good thing for a designer?

Formatting + Stipulations

- 1. Papers need to be 3-5 pages in length, double-spaced, using Times New Roman or Helvetica, 12 pt font.
- 2. Absolutely, positively use spell check and grammar check! There is NO reason that there should be spelling mistakes in your paper.
- 3. Paper must include a works cited page (use MLA style), citing Rutledge's article and any other articles or references you use.
- 4. Read the paper aloud (to yourself or friends). Is it easy to follow? Can your listener summarize your main parts? If not, you need to re-write sections to clarify your intentions.
- Take your paper to the writing center to get advice from a writing specialist.
- 6. Email a rough draft to me one week prior to the due date so you have time to make corrections and revisions as necessary.
- 7. Papers must be turned in on time. For each hour your paper is late, you lose 5 points.

*NOTE: It is expected that your paper will have gone through spell check and grammar check. If this is not the case you will earn no higher than a <u>C.</u> no matter how good the quality of your paper.
