

**ASSIGNMENT 11**  
**GOAL:**

To understand and apply color for accessibility in screen-based interfaces.

**PROCESS**

- 1) Open up the template for screen based interfaces in Illustrator. Select a limited palette of no more than three or four colors.
- 2) In the template, you'll notice that each text layer and background colors are on different layers. The logo is locked, so don't try to change it.
- 3) Using the lecture as your guide, select colors for the text and backgrounds. Keep in mind that a simple palette is best for this assignment.
- 4) Take your finished assignment into the contrast checker and save a screenshot of the color accessibility test.
- 5) When you're finished, save the file as a .pdf and label it with your name\_A11. Email it to me, along with the screenshot of the contrast check, before the start of class on Thursday, April 7th.

**YOUR ASSIGNMENT WILL BE ASSESSED USING THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA**

How well did you apply an accessible color palette to the interface design template? /25

Did you limit your color palette to two or three colors to help with accessibility? /25

Did you create an interface with sufficient contrast and can you describe your process? /25

Care and craft, did you save your file as a .pdf, submit a screenshot from the contrast checker, and label your assignment correctly? /25
