

Paper 3: Technology and Surveillance

Paper Due: Wednesday, November 1 at the beginning of class

Based on class lectures and readings write a 3-5 page-paper that addresses multimedia and interactivity. Use examples from class lectures, readings, and your **own research** to discuss the following questions.

- 1) Jonathan Lee explained Chat GPT and prompting. How does chat GPT find answers to your questions?
- 2) Although it is tempting to copy and paste chat GPT answers directly into a school paper or a document, state at least two reasons why you should never do this.
- 3) Bias exists in Large Language Models (LLM's), describe how this can happen
- 4) What are some of the risks of bias in LLM's and AI-driven software?

Formatting + Stipulations

1. Papers need to be 3-5 pages in length, double-spaced, using Helvetica or Times New Roman, 12 pt font.
2. Absolutely, positively use spell check and grammar check! There is NO reason that there should be spelling mistakes in your paper.
3. The paper must include a work cited (use MLA style), citing the reading and any other articles or references you use.
4. Read the paper aloud (to yourself or friends). Is it easy to follow? Can your listener summarize your main parts? If not, you need to re-write sections to clarify your intentions.
5. Email a rough draft to me one week prior to the due date so you have time to make corrections and revisions as necessary.
6. Papers must be turned in on time. You will lose 5 points for every hour your paper is late.

***NOTE: It is expected that your paper will have gone through spell check and grammar check. If this is not the case you will earn no higher than a C, no matter how good the quality of your paper.**
